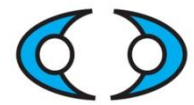
# Overview of CitizenScape project

- **Part of the EU eParticipation funding line**
- **CitizenScape**
- **eParticipation in Legislation Implementation**  
A service
  - that will integrate Web 2.0 tools in concrete legislative & decision-making processes
  - to engage Citizens in the local implementation of EU environmental legislation.
- **12 month pilot trial at Local & Regional level**
  - Most immediately relevant to most citizens
  - 4 regions with very diverse legislative contexts
    - Italy, Ireland, Slovakia & UK



# Design assumptions

- People are already participating – just not in the place that we want then to!
- Web 2.0 means that people have a 'domicile' online and want content to come to them
- Content already exists – we need to re-use it
- Co-creation means talking with citizens not at them and having shared ownership of the conversation space
- We need to embed the idea of “What next”
- We want to create a sense of people moving from informal to formal – we are social engineering!



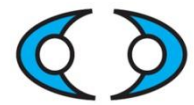
# Core CitizenScape concepts

- We want to use best of breed tools – hierarchy of borrow, buy, build
- Web 2.0 architecture:
  - **Container** – owns the general attributes such as content tags, design, timeline, user management
  - Three types of **widgets** within these containers:
    - Internal: Public-i 'native' functionality
    - External read only: Data fed in from other sites
    - External interactive: External sites with which we can interact
  - To follow: Two '**mobile**' widgets outside the container
    - Advertising / 'teaser' widget
    - Independent widget
- We are also creating a formal offline methodology for engagement

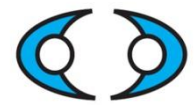
