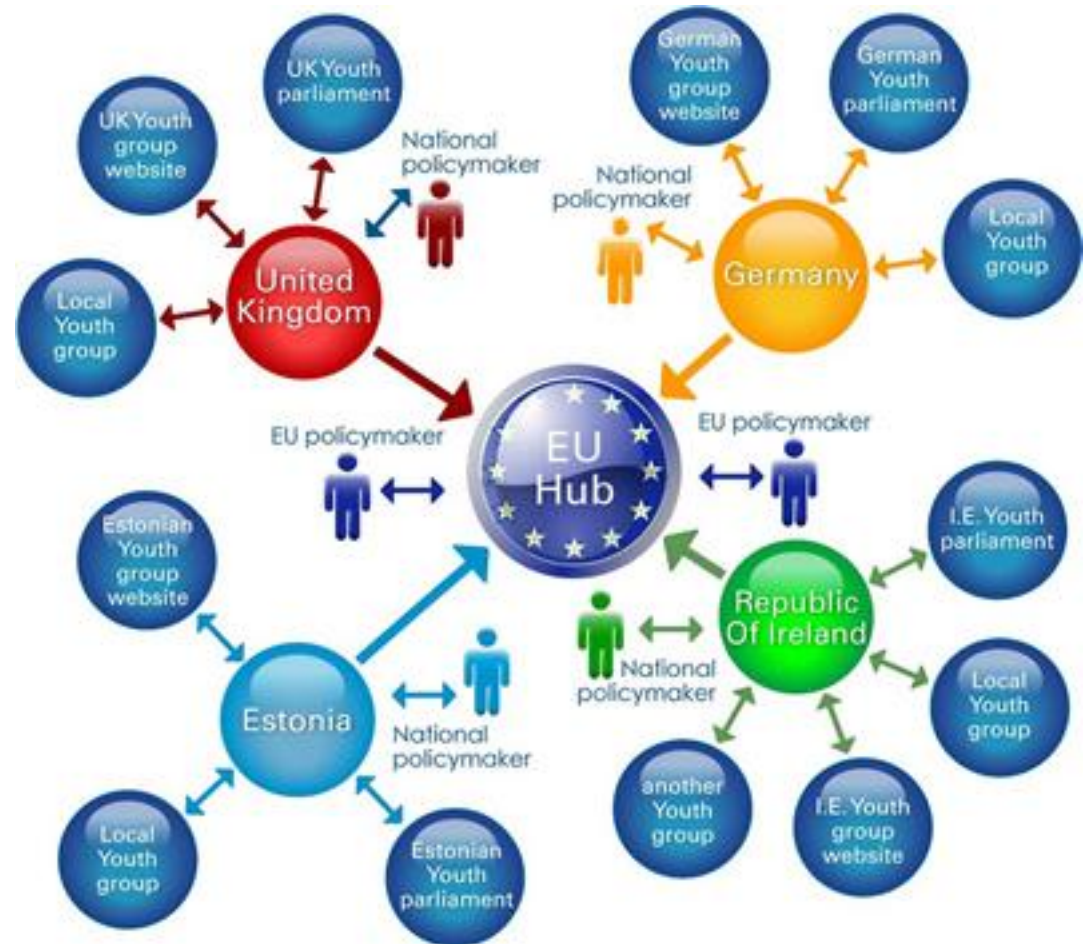

- 2 years from January 2009
- Launch December 2009
- Sponsored by EC under the eParticipation Preparatory Action



How it works

- Young people hold discussions in *their own online spaces*
- Information & support on HUWY Hubs
- Young people add their results and ideas to the Hubs
- Results organised & tagged, by and for policy-makers
- Policy-makers provide feedback and young people can respond
- Plus workshops offline for young people (local, national, international)

Using SN sites

- Young people can use SN sites for their discussions
- Hubs built on blog engine (WordPress) and wikis
- HUWY project to use SNS to promote to young people and policy-makers
